Dear Parents and Students,

Winter/spring dance session begins January 8th and runs through June 24th. Please refer to the Winter/Spring Calendar for pertinent dates.

For our June show, we will be performing an original production of Mary Poppins written by Kelsey Snyder called *Wind in the East*.

Registration: To ensure class placement, please fill out the Enrollment Form, Production Participation Form, and Costume Policy and return along with costume fees (tuition payments are due the first day of class). We have rolling admission through January 31st, however, to ensure class placement, please submit enrollment forms and costume fees as soon as possible. A student's place in class will not be reserved until all papers and costume fees are submitted. Costumes are ordered in early January so any student enrolling later in the month will incur extra costume costs. Scholarship applications are due by December 15th. Any student who was not enrolled in the fall session also needs to fill out the Contact Information form and the Liability Release form. These forms are available on the website and at the dance studio.

Classes and Fees: Class prices are listed on the enrollment form and are for the entire session (Jan-June). Please note the Discount Packages that are available. Individual payment plans can be worked out if needed, however, we request that parents keep track of when payments are due and make sure that tuition is paid in a timely manner.

Class Placement: During the first week of class, instructors make sure that students are in the appropriate class and suggest alternative classes if necessary. We stress the importance of ballet for all our students. The class enrollment form lists our recommendations for each level for proper training and progress.

Dress Code: In dance, it is a sign of disrespect to arrive to class looking sloppy. Our dress code is available on our website. Parents, please review it so that you are clear on what your child/teen should wear to class.

2018 Production: All students may participate in the production and will perform in both shows.

Absences: All absences must be cleared with the class instructor otherwise they will be considered unexcused. Students with 3 unexcused absences may be dismissed from the program. Simply not showing up to class is not acceptable. If a student is going to be absent, please notify us by calling or texting 496-0805 or emailing us. Students are highly encouraged to make-up any missed classes by attending another class in their level. Make-up classes should be done within 2 weeks of a student being absent. Just call or email us to let us know when your child/teen will be attending a make-up class. Level I, II and Level III students who are unable to dance but are not contagious are expected to attend class and observe.

Safety: Students are not permitted to wait outdoors for transportation. Parents, please escort your children to and from the dance studio.

Participation Form**

Participation in the June production is a six-month commitment, which we take very seriously and expect our students to as well. Costumes are ordered in early January, and choreography is taught. Student absences are disruptive. This is why it is very important that both parents and students read the following and sign.

The **Photo Shoot** for program and cast photos will be on **Sunday, May 20th**. As it gets closer, we will email out instructions and the schedule but please note that any student who does not attend will be not have her/his photo included in the program.

Also, please note the **additional rehearsals for Levels II, III, and IV** that are scheduled for May 30, June 5, and June 12 (these dates are subject to change).

(Please read carefully before signing) I understand that I am making a commitment that will extend from January through June 24th. I will make participation in the production and my dance classes a priority over other activities and will honor my commitment to attend class regularly, to dress appropriately, and to consider my dance schedule before making commitments to other activities. I understand that if I have 3 unexcused absences I may be dismissed from the production. I also understand that I must attend all dress rehearsals and participate in both performances.

I agree that my child/teen will attend class regularly and participate in all dress rehearsals and both performances. **If my child/teen does not fulfill this commitment or if my child/teen is dismissed from the production for excessive absences or for unprofessional conduct, I agree to pay the full amount of tuition owed from January to June plus any costs that went into costuming my child/teen.**

I also understand that the Photo Shoot is May 20th and that if my child/teen is in Levels II, III, or IV, she/he has rehearsals on May 30, June 5, and June 12 (these dates are subject to change) and that these rehearsals are mandatory.

2018 June Production Costume Policy

Parents and Students: Please read the following carefully, sign at the bottom, and submit with costume fees.

Tutus for Tots, Intro Level Classes: \$65.00

Students in Intro level classes will wear the same costume for all classes.

Level I Costume: Hip Hop I and Tap I: \$65.00 Wed Ballet/Jazz I and Fri Ballet I: \$65.00

Level II Costumes: Ballet II: \$70.00 Hip Hop II and Contemporary/Lyrical: \$65.00

Tap II and Musical Theater Jazz II: \$75.00 (Students in these classes will be chimney sweeps and will be responsible for making their own chimney broom prop. Parents will be texted instructions once we figure it out ourselves.)

Level III Costumes: Contemporary/Lyrical II/III, Tap III, Jazz/Hip Hop III: \$65.00 Ballet III Tues: \$70.00
Ballet III Thurs: \$70.00

Level IV Costumes: No costume fees are due until after casting has been posted in January. Parents should expect to purchase 2-3 costumes.

General Costume Policies: Students must complete both performances in order to keep the costume that was ordered for them. Students who do not complete the production will not be able to keep their costumes and costume fees will not be refunded. Once costumes arrive, we will try them on during one of the classes, and the student's parent or responsible adult will be required to attend. Parents will be responsible for any alterations that need to be made to the costume. If the parent takes the costume home and the costume is lost or damaged, the student will not be able to participate in the production unless a second costume can be ordered in which case the parent must cover all expenses. The Ferndale Dance Academy is not responsible for any damage to the costume. Parents are also informed that costumes are not custom fit for your child and may not fit perfectly. We must order costumes in January. When measuring your child, please keep in mind the growth that will take place between January and June. If a costume needs to be exchanged for an alternate size, parents must cover all associated costs. Students and parents are also responsible for the care of any costume or prop the student borrows from costume storage, and parents will be responsible for any damage caused to the costume or prop out of negligence.
