Welcome to our Winter/Spring 2026 Season!

Registration: To enroll, please fill out and return pages 4 and 5. Students who were NOT enrolled in our Fall 2025 Season also need to submit the Contact Information and Liability Release forms (available separately on the studio website as pdfs). Please drop forms off at the studio, mail to the above address, or email to the studio.

We encourage ALL of our students to dance a minimum of two days a week and to take ballet. Ballet is the foundation for proper dance training.

Class Fees: Class prices are listed on page 4 and are for the entire session (Jan - June). Payments can be made by paying cash or check at the studio, mailing checks to the above address, or going to the studio homepage to pay online. The calendar on page 3 shows the dates tuition installments are due. We expect all students who enroll to complete the full session. Discount packages apply only to students enrolling in the full session.

June Performances: All classes except Beginning Pointe will prepare a dance for the June performances. Please see page 5 for the Participation Agreement and details.

Studio Photography is Back! We will be having an optional photo day on Sunday, April 19 at Scurfield Photography for parents to sign up to have studio portraits taken of their dancers in costume.

FDA CODE OF CONDUCT:

- **Dress Code:** Our dress code is available on the website, and we do expect our students to abide by it. Parents, please review to make sure that you are clear on what your child/teen is required to wear to class. Students in Levels 2-4 who show up to class unprepared in regards to the dress code will be required to observe rather than participate in class. We have a studio online store through Discount Dance. A link is available on the studio website. We expect all students to look nicely put together for class.
- **Tardiness:** All students are expected to arrive a few minutes early so that they are ready to begin class on time.
- **Absences:** All students are expected to keep absences to an absolute minimum. We ask that parents text the studio if their child/teen is going to be absent. Any student showing a sign of illness should not attend class. If a student in Levels II-IV is injured but not ill, she/he should attend class to observe. For the convenience of students and parents, a student roster logging the number of absences for each student will be posted in the downstairs foyer so that parents and students can easily keep track and work towards exemplary class attendance.
- **Observers:** Observers are not allowed in the classroom unless it is cleared ahead of time with the instructor. Observers for Tutus for Tots are only allowed on the first day of class and only if it is needed. Students are ready for Tutus for Tots when they can participate in the class by themselves.
- **Class Etiquette:** A student is ready to participate in dance classes when they can listen, focus, and follow directions and treat their instructors and fellow dancers with respect.
- **Performance Etiquette:** We distribute a Recital Handbook prior to our performances that outlines clear instructions for participating in our shows. These rules are essential to our rehearsals and performances running smoothly, and all participants and their families are expected to follow them.

Show Information

Participants: All classes EXCEPT Beginning Pointe.

Attendance: It is simply not possible for instructors to prepare dances properly without all students in class each week so students are expected to have exceptional attendance and to "save their absences" for when they are ill and are not able to attend class.

Location: Arkley Center for the the Performing Arts, Eureka

Dates: There will be two group rehearsals at the studio during the two weeks leading up to the shows (Does not include Tutus for Tots. Days/Time TBA). Dress rehearsal and performances at the Arkley June 12-14.

Costumes: All costumes are \$80 each. Payments can be made by cash, check, or credit card online. If paying with a debit card for costumes and video recording, please add a \$5 service charge fee. Hip Hop I/II and Hip Hop III/IV will be creating their own costume so no costume fee will be due for these classes. Parents will be texted links to the specific items needed. Both Tutus classes will wear the same costume. Intro Tap and Intro Jazz/Hip Hop will wear the same costume. Costume fees are due at this time. In addition to costumes, parents will be responsible for purchasing the required tights, shoes, and accessories. Parents are also responsible for paying any fees if a costume must be exchanged for a different size.
